*In primary my experience with eczema was not the best especially in year 1. From nursery to reception the picking on and calling names were not bad due to my shyness and dislike of crowded places I was not one to socialise I preferred to chill and play by myself as this felt more comfortable to me.*

*Year 1 hmm what a year many days would go by when I would continually get teased on for wanting to be alone being different and for the way my skin looked due to my eczema. Many comments said were very hurtful. For many reasons I couldn't understand how some people could be so mean and not understanding.*

*"Can I catch it?" "Ewww what was that?" "Why's your hand so dry?"  
"Why are you itching?" "Why does your hand look like that?"  
"Stop itching!" "Don't touch her she's diseased!" "Ewwwww!"  
"It looks like crocodile skin" "Why is your hand cracking?"  
"Ewww that feels nasty!" "Ewww your diseased"  
"Ewww she has germs!" "Run from her!"  
"Stop ruining your clothes"  
"What's that?"  
"What are you hiding?" "Can it spread?"  
"Why are you pulling down your sleeve?"*

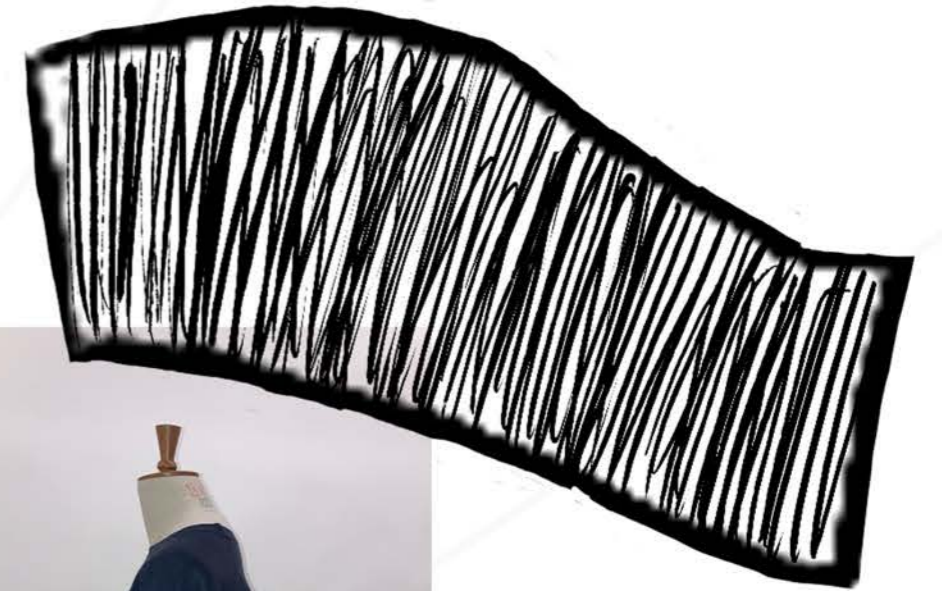
*From year 2 to year 6 I didn't have many problems with people n commenting on my hand because people have gotten used to it and I used to always pull my Sleeve down past my wrist stretching it past my fingers to cover my hand from everyone and protect myself from the hurtful comments and words. There was always a rear occasion where people would say something as a last resort to get under my skin which always did the trick to tick of my tears again.*

*My secondary experience went by so quick I was able to hide my eczema for the whole 5 years but on some rare occasions **there were some slip ups.** Only close friends or people who sat next to me will know because it was hard to write and hold my sleeve at the same time also my eczema started to get better and disappear until year 10.*

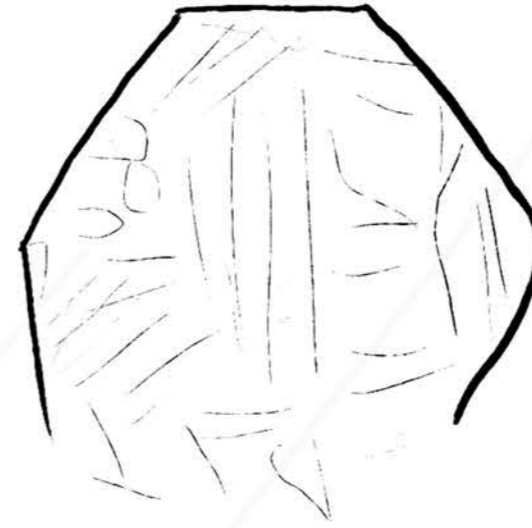
*In year 10 and 11 was where my eczema got worse due to an infection from a kayaking experience in the river Thames. This infection made my **eczema more visible to the people** around me due to the swelling and bandages I had to wear. With these things obviously in site people noticed and ask questions about my hand. I would just give them a simple explanation or just say I have eczema that got irritated or that I had **sensitive skin.** But then a lot of people were understanding and fine with it because they knew someone who had eczema or they have had it themselves, which made me more comfortable explaining and helped me stop hiding my hand*
